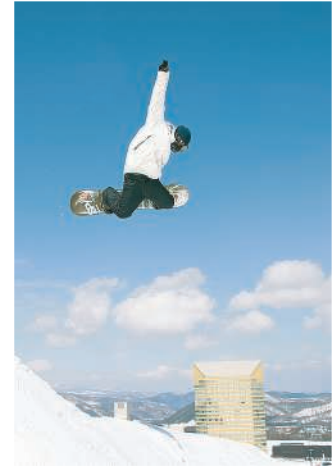


# APPI SKI RESORT

<b>A</b> Shirakaba	1,000m	300-70	9-16	Facing Appi Resort Center, perfect terrain for beginners and families
<b>B</b> Hayabusa	3,000m	70-30	19-30	Certified for giant slalom competition and one of the most popular trail
<b>C</b> Otaka	3,000m	70-30	16-31	Wild one that starts from the steep peak
<b>D</b> Kakesu	1,500m	50-35	12-24	Steer away from Otaka and you can brush up the basics here
<b>E</b> Kakko	2,800m	50-30	14-28	Skiers only. Enjoy the variation from steep to mellow
<b>F</b> Kitsutsuki	2,200m	50-30	12-28	Skiers only. Great cruising course for mellow times
<b>G</b> Yamagara	900m	50-20	23-32	Famed for the best snow quality. No grooming, just powder
<b>H</b> Inuwashi	1,000m	80-25	16-30	Groomed only once a week to leave room for deep powder needs
<b>I</b> Yamabato	5,500m	30-15	15-20	Longest trail from top to bottom, ideal for easy riders
<b>J</b> Sekirei	1,600m	80-15	10-26	Connecting Sailer and Central areas and early/late season's favorite
<b>K</b> Karugamo	1 200m	30 15	10 15	Route to Appi Grand Villa and is a beginner's favorite

<b>L</b> Sailer Long	4,000m	80-30	14-26	One of Appi's symbolic cruise that rolls into Sailer area
<b>M</b> Sailer 1 A	2,500m	80-25	10-22	Varied situations entertain intermediate to advanced levels as well
<b>N</b> Sailer 1 B	1,100m	70-30	13-18	Straight slope with moderate steepness leading to Sailer Quad
<b>O</b> Sailer 1 C	2,700m	65-40	11-20	Parallel to Sailer Long, straight with not much twist
<b>P</b> Sailer 2 A	2,300m	70-30	16-34	Never groomed is this tough and wild one with bumps and snowdrifts
<b>Q</b> Sailer 2 B	2,500m	60-30	11-26	Rather mellow connecting route but still has kicks
<b>R</b> Sailer 2 C	2,000m	50-25	10-25	Many people's favorite with its spacious setup
<b>S</b> Second 1	2,500m	100-30	13-28	Great views and flat slopes make everyone in all levels just happy
<b>T</b> Second 2	1,000m	100-50	12-21	Spacious but not just mellow, be prepared for the roller coaster ride
<b>U</b> Second 3	800m	55-33	13-32	At the end of the area is this non-tamed powder paradise
